

## VISIT TO BETINA MUSEUM OF WOODEN SHIPBUILDING, HOUSE OF DALMATIAN PROSCIUTTO AND SKAULJ ECO WINERY



Discover the magic of wooden boats and learn more about the past of the island of Murter in the authentic environment of the Museum of Wooden Shipbuilding located in the small village of Betina. After the tour around the museum and short free time in Betina we will continue our tour towards the countryside in order to visit the House of Dalmatian Prosciutto. Kind hosts will introduce us to the entire process of prosciutto production and at the end you will get the chance to taste all their products. Lunch will be served on their estate in the shade under the vine. They serve traditional Dalmatian dish – peka, consisting of veal and rooster meat with vegetables baked in the pot under the dome bell that is called peka in Croatian. The pot is put into the embers of a fireplace and baked there for a couple of hours. There is no better pair to a good meal than a fine wine, that is why after the lunch we will be driving towards the small village of Nadin, also known as the most eco-friendly village in Croatia. In Nadin we are going to visit Skaulj family winery and taste three of their famous wines. This winery is also the first ecological winery in Croatia, where grapes and wine are produced according to strict criteria of ecological food and drink production. Their wines are official wines of the European Parliament and they have even been visited by the King and Queen of Sweden. After the tasting tour we will return back to Zadar.
